Chairman Ralph Bilby called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Hearing on Case 39, originally scheduled for 10:00 a.m., has been postponed until January 21, 1970.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Discussion was held on that portion of the Executive Secretary's report regarding the salt dome in the Glendale area northwest of Phoenix and the concern of Luke Air Force Base officials that contemplated mining of the salt by Southwest Salt Company would contaminate the wells supplying fresh water to Luke Field and diminish its water supply. After full discussion, the Commissioners directed a letter to Governor Williams stating that, in their opinion, this Commission has no standing in law as to the water pollution problem here contemplated and suggesting that the proper agency to supervise this operation would be the Water Pollution Control Council.


Report of the Geologist was accepted.
