MINUTES OF HEARING RANGER DEVELOPMENT WELL SPACING EXCEPTIONS July 12, 2017

CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Thorwald called the OGCC Public Hearing of July 12, 2017 to order at 1:03 p.m. in Room 3100B, Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, Phoenix, Arizona.

<u>DISCUSSION of RANGER DEVELOPMENT, L.L.C. WELL SPACING EXCCEPTIONS FOR THE 9-1 PDS, 33-3 PD and 34-3 PD.</u>

Ranger had previously submitted complete well spacing applications for the three wells. This facilitated an expedited review and approval during the Public Hearing. There were no objections by members of the public that were present. Copies of the entire well package submitted by Ranger for each well is a public record that is available for review and can be found in each well file.

The Commission unanimously voted in favor of all of the following well spacing proposals:

- Approve spacing exception for proposed Ranger 9-1
- Approve spacing exception for proposed Ranger 33-3
- Approve spacing exception for proposed Ranger34-3

The Commission did not approve the Administrator's recommendation to delay the issuance of the 34-3 drill permit until Ranger received approval of an Energy Mineral Drilling Surface Use Plan permit from the Arizona State Land Department. Instead, the Commission approved the Administrator to issue a permit for the 34-3, conditioned upon approval of the Arizona State Land Department's permit.
